Dear Parents, Carers and students,

I'm delighted to inform you that the long awaited 2022 Sherburn High School Sports Day will take place on Wednesday 20th July 2022. Shown below are some frequently asked questions regarding the event to ensure that the day runs smoothly:

What will the day look like?

Timings	Activity
08:20 - 09:00	Period 1 as normal
09:00 - 12:00	Students signed up for field events complete these during the course of the morning. Those participating in field events will be collected from lessons by their Heads of Year.
	All other students will be in lessons as normal.
	Break will also take place as normal between 11:00 and 11:15.
LUNCH 12:00 – 12:40	Years 7 and 9 will go to lunch early at 12:00
	Years 8 and 10 will remain in lessons until 12:15, before being dismissed for lunch.
12:40 - 13:00	Students go to their form rooms to be registered by their form tutors.
	Students escorted to the top field by their form tutor.
13:00 - 14:30	Track events Staggered dismissal at the end of the school day.

What will my child need to wear?

All students are asked to arrive in school in their PE uniform and, where students have them, wear their Summer House polo shirt for the day. For students whose normal PE kit is black leggings, a suitable pair of shorts instead of leggings is allowed, with either their white PE top or House polo shirt.

Is there anything else my child needs to bring on the day?

If the weather conditions permit, both participants and spectators will be on the school field for around an hour and half in the afternoon. As such, it is important that they bring plenty of water to stay hydrated, along with sun cream and a hat.

Will it be compulsory to take part in a track/field event on the day?

No – although we'd encourage as many students to get involved as possible! Students wanting to compete in either field or track events will sign up during PE lessons prior to the event.

In the afternoon, any students who aren't competing in events will be spectating and cheering on their house team!

We know what will happen if the weather is too hot, but what if the weather is poor? Will the event still go ahead?

If the weather is really poor, then a decision will be made Tuesday evening or in the morning to cancel the event.

In the event of this taking place, students will revert to their normal school timetable.
