Arrangements for Monday 21st November 2022

After consultation with Student Leadership groups and other local Headteachers - we will be allowing students in Years 7 – 11 to watch the England v. Iran World Cup game on the afternoon of Monday 21st November in classrooms, supervised by staff. As this is the only England match to be played during the school day, this is a one-off exceptional opportunity for the students and staff to come together in this way.

We recognise the concerns about the World Cup being held in Qatar, with its human rights record and views on the LGBTQ+ community, and so will be ensuring that our students have opportunities to consider these issues as part of our Personal Development curriculum.

We also appreciate that there will be students who do not wish to watch the match. These students should bring homework or a reading book with them.

Post 16 Students who attend lessons at Tadcaster Grammar School on Monday afternoon have the option of studying there. Students who have timetabled lessons at Sherburn High School have the option of watching the football or accessing additional revision resources on Google Classroom in supervised and supported study areas.

Please note that Monday is not a non-uniform day. Normal mobile phone rules apply and that students should have their full equipment with them.
