

Returning to school in September 2023

Please see below a reminder for the dates each year group returns to school

Monday 4 th September	Year 12 Registration
Tuesday 5 th September	Years 11 and 7 return
Wednesday 6 th September	Years 7 – 11 in school
Thursday 7 th September	Post 16 lessons begin

All students will return in their traditional school uniform (blazers and shirts) and will require full equipment (details are on our website and in student planners).

From September there will be a minor adjustment to the school day, this is to bring Sherburn High School in line with the government directive that schools offer 32.5 hours per week to students. Period one will now start at 8:30 a.m. and our staggered end to the day will begin at 2:45 p.m. with all students being dismissed by 3:00 p.m. School buses will continue to run as normal. Extra-curricular activities will therefore start at 3:00 p.m. and end by 4:00 p.m.
