

Dear parents, carers and students,

Coronavirus Update:

As you will be aware, on Wednesday 19th January, the Prime Minister announced that face coverings in classrooms are no longer required. In addition, from Thursday 27th January, face coverings in communal areas will no longer be required.

As has been the case throughout the pandemic:

- Staff and students are able to continue to wear a face covering in the classroom and on corridors if this supports their wellbeing;
- We will consult with Public Health England if in the future, case numbers within our school community begin to rise, and may, under their guidance recommend a return to face coverings for all if necessary;
- We will continue to review our risk assessments and government guidance and update you accordingly.
