The Class of 2022

Yesterday the Department of Education published their Secondary School performance data in England: 2021-22. And I am delighted to share with you our Progress 8 Score.

Progress 8 is a score that shows how much progress pupils make across 8 qualifications between the end of Key Stage 2 and the end of Key Stage 4, compared to other similar pupils nationally. A score of 0 means that students perform as expected, in line with their peers.

We are delighted that our students performed well above other students in schools in North Yorkshire and nationally, as can be seen below.

The progress 8 score for students at Sherburn High School was 0.46; a phenomenal achievement for our Class of 2022!

North Yorkshire Safeguarding Review

On Monday 10th October a Safeguarding Review, led by North Yorkshire, took place at Sherburn High School. The review team looked at all aspects of Safeguarding – checking health and safety, support for students who are struggling, referrals and work with social services and our Personal Development Curriculum.

The team met with students, observed them in lessons, break and lunchtime. They also spoke with a wide range of staff as well as members of the Local Governing Body and STAR MAT.

I am delighted to share with you that the outcome of the review deemed “Safeguarding to be effective at Sherburn High School.” And in particular, I am very proud of the feedback the team gave about our students – who they described as “A real credit to you” and “Impeccably behaved.”
