

To help parents/carers navigate the complex world of social media, we are inviting all parents and carers to attend a workshop run by the NSPCC, on Tuesday 4th October. The workshop will cover the following topics:

- What children and young people are doing online
- Parental concerns
- What the risks are for young people in terms of what they see, do and who they meet online
- How to manage these risks as a parent
- Sources of help/support

The workshop will also focus on the following areas of online usage – sharing nudes, online friendships, live streaming and online hoaxes, challenges, and scams.
