

## Strike action by members of the National Education Union (NEU)

I am pleased to be able to tell you that the previously published plans for Wednesday 1st February, remain in place. See below for details:

Year 7 and Year 11	<ul> <li>School is open.</li> <li>School buses will run as normal.</li> <li>School catering will be as normal</li> </ul>
Years 8, 9 and 10	<ul> <li>School is closed.</li> <li>Students should complete their homework, access work where it is set on Google Classrooms and complete independent study. There will be no live lessons via Google Classrooms for students.</li> </ul>
Year 12 & 13	<ul> <li>School is open.</li> <li>School buses will run as normal.</li> <li>School catering as normal.</li> <li>Most consortium lessons at Sherburn High School should take place.</li> <li>Where lessons are not taking place due to striking teachers, students are expected to complete independent study in the P rooms until their next lesson.</li> </ul>

Families in Years 8, 9 and 10 who are eligible for free school meals can order a packed lunch for collection; arrangements for this have been communicated to you separately but if you have any questions, please do not hesitate to contact your child's Head of Year.

Separate arrangements for the strike days planned for February and March 2023 (below) will be communicated individually:

- Tuesday 28th February: Schools in north and north-west England, Yorkshire and Humber.
- Wednesday 15th and Thursday 16th March: All schools in England and Wales.
