- Torch (with fresh batteries) a head torch is ideal
- Sun cream (weather dependant)
- Sun hat (weather dependant)



MAIN LUGGAGE

(Transported to camp on a trailer)

- Warm sleeping bag (Season 3 recommended)
- ☐ Roll mat
- Tracksuit of hardwearing trousers
- □ T-shirts
- Waterproof trousers
- ☐ Socks and underwear
- 2x pairs of footwear (e.g. walking boots and old trainers)
- ☐ Wash bag including toothbrush, toothpaste, soap and face wipers
- Towel(s)
- Wellington Boots (weather dependant)
- Warm hat, scarf and gloves (weather dependant)
- Thermal layers (weather dependant)
