- 08:00 Students to meet at Leeds Bradford Airport
- 08:15 Check in at airport Leeds Bradford International Airport
- 10:15 Flight Departure Jet2. Hand luggage and online check-in are included. Exact flights TBC.
- 14:25 Flight Arrival Málaga Airport
- 15:25 Transfer Coach. Private return airport transfers in Spain are included.
- 16:00 Approx Check-in to Accommodation - Feel Hostels Soho Malaga.
Located in Malaga's artistic and creative district, the Feel Hostels Soho Malaga is a bright, modern hostel, which is also just footsteps from the city centre. Your meal plan is HALF-BOARD. Your first meal will be Dinner. Based on students in ensuite multi-bed rooms.
- 17:00 Self-guided Tour Málaga Highlights! Discover the city with a self-guided walking tour!

- 19:00 Activity/M meal Málaga Tapas Tour.
Get a flavour of traditional Andalusian cuisine with an outstanding guided tapas tour! Duration: 2 hours. Dinner included.

- 08:00 Meal Breakfast at accommodation
- 10:00 Museum Centre Pompidou Málaga
Housed in a multi-coloured cube, Málaga's brand-new Pompidou Centre is the only branch of the museum to be found outside France! The diverse collection spans works from 1905 to the present day.
- 12:30 Market Mercado Central de Atarazanas.
Pick up lunch and sample traditional Andalusian cuisine at Málaga's central market.
- 14:30 Visit La Alcazaba
Constructed during the Caliphate period, the original purpose of Málaga's palace-fortress was to defend against pirates. You will be able to visit La Alcazaba, the Castillo de Gibralfaro and Teatro Romano at your own leisure.
- Visit Castillo de Gibralfaro. The magnificent Castillo de Gibralfaro sits on a high hill overlooking Málaga city and port, and dates back to the 10th century.
- Visit Teatro Romano. Málaga's Roman Theatre is one of the only remaining symbols of Roman Hispania in the city. The Theatre has been returned to its original use and different types of shows now take place inside.

- 17:00 Approx At leisure Playa de la Malagueta.
Playa de la Malagueta is located between Puerto de Málaga and Playa de La Caleta and is one of the most popular beaches in Málaga!
- 21:00 Dinner at a local restaurant. A 2-course evening meal is included.

Sat 07 Mar 2026

- 08:30 Meal Breakfast at accommodation
- 10:30 Visit Catedral de la Encarnación de Málaga
Málaga's Renaissance and Baroque-style cathedral was never properly completed - unfinished yet mightily impressive cathedrals seem to be something of a trend in Andalucía!
- 12:00 Approx At leisure Centro Histórico
Explore Málaga's vibrant Old Town known for its blend of Roman, Moorish, and Renaissance architecture.
- 13:30 Museum Museo Picasso Málaga.
Housed in an old Nasrid Palace, the Picasso Museum explores the work of the artist from the late 19th century up to his death in 1973.
- 17:45 Transfer Coach. Private return airport transfers in Spain are included.
- 18:35 Check in at airport Málaga Airport
- 20:35 Flight Departure Jet2. Exact flights are subject to availability at the time of booking.
- 22:45 Flight arrival Leeds Bradford International Airport
- 23:00 Students to be collected from the Airport
