## Acceptable Use Policy – Wireless / Bring Your Own Device – Post16

## **General information**

Access to the 6th form wireless facility is filtered in compliance with the School's Acceptable Use Policy. However, access from personal devices is limited to internet use only. Users will not have direct access to any documents or facilities that reside on the school network from their personal devices. Any use of the facility entails personal responsibility and compliance with all academy rules and policies. Gaming devices are NOT allowed.

## **Guidelines for use**

- Use of personal devices during the school day is at the discretion of teachers and staff
- The primary purpose of the use of personal devices at the school is educational
- The use of a personal device is not to be a distraction in any way to teachers, staff or other students. The use of a device must not distract others in any way
- The use of personal devices is covered by the Sherburn High School ICT Acceptable Use policy
- Users must not share their user details with other users to gain access to devices
- Students must bring their personal devices to school fully charged
- Students must not attempt to circumvent the school network security and/or filtering. This includes attempting to bypass proxies or use VPN software / apps
- Devices must be in silent mode at all times
- There may be consequences for misuse/disruption
- The student may be refused permission to use personal devices on school property
- Disciplinary action may be taken in accordance with existing school policies school liability statement
- You bring your own personal device(s) to use at Sherburn High School at your own risk. It is your duty to be responsible in the upkeep and protection of your device(s). Access to the facility may be monitored, suspended or terminated at any time if this policy is not adhered to

Sherburn High School will not be responsible for:

- Personal devices that are broken or damaged while at school or during school-related activities
- Personal devices that are lost or stolen at school or during school-related activities
- Maintenance or upkeep of any personal devices
- Technical support of personal devices. However you may ask questions to IT Support and we can advise you on a solution. It is at your discretion and your own decision if you choose to act upon this advice.
